

PREAMBLE

We. the Youth, children, climate and environmental Activist. for organizations. gathered the climate change symposium on youth and children in Mogadishu, Somalia, from 23to 24 October 2023, in the presence of government officials, private sector representatives, civil society organizations, women, and academia, hereby:

- 1. **Appreciate** the Institute of climate and environment of SIMAD University and Save Children Somalia for organizing the Climate change symposium for youth and children that aims to empower the youth and children in Mogadishu.
- 2. **Recognize** the critical importance of the youth and children as drivers of change and the custodians of our shared future.
- 3. **Commend** the commitment of all interested stakeholders in Somalia to contribute addressing the urgent issues of climate change and it's cascading impact of livelihood and wellbeing of the people.
- 4. **Express** a concern that the expected impact of El Niño which may result loss of lives and livehoods of the vulnerable people those are exposed to the crisis.

- 5. **Acknowledge** that climate change poses a severe threat to our environment, economy, and social fabric, and its impacts are most acutely felt by the vulnerable, particularly the children and youth.
- 6. Reaffirm the principles set out in United Nations Framework the Convention Climate on Change (UNFCCC) and its Paris Agreement, namely eauity. common differentiated responsibilities, and respective capabilities.
- Recognize the progressive achievements of Ministry Environment and Climate Change of Federal Government of in tackling the climate crisis through institutional building, strengthening, systems policy enaction, and stakeholder engagement towards climate adaption realization and of Sustainable development Goals (SDGs) in the spirit of #GreenerSomalia.
- 8. **Emphasize** the importance Somalia's participation at COP28 with considerations the voice of Somali children and youth to achieve climate adaptation, resilience building and sustainable future for current generation and generations to come.

COLLECTIVE **ACTION** NEEDED

1. To the Federal Government of Somalia, we urge:

- Accelerate the co-creation of a) rights-based legal framework and implementation of policies and strategies that prioritize climate change mitigation and adaptation, with a focus on youth and children.
- Expend the Collaboration with b) local communities, academia, and all other partners to effectively address climate change-related issues.

2. To the Civil society organizations (CSOs), we ask:

Α. Enhance cooperation and among coordination **CSOs** to maximize the impact of climate-related Actions.

Advocate for increased R comprehensive support to advance and impact-oriented initiatives and programs towards resilience building and locally led climate adaptation across Somalia.

To private institutions and the Somali community, we urge:

- To Champion the transition of eco-friendly sustainability and practices towards Net-Zero
- To cooperate with academia, and youth organizations in supporting their climate initiatives through corporate social responsibility and other support systems
- Play active roles in mentoring and engaging youth and children in climate action. education. and awareness campaigns.

4. We acknowledge the critical importance of youth and children in climate action by:

Recognizing their innovative ideas, energy,



and determination as valuable assets in the fight against climate change.


b) Emphasizing the need to provide education and support for young leaders and environmental advocates to drive change.
